ANOTHER REMINDER

This summer I penned a column in which I noted how we had updated the ways in which we can make our donations to Vineville Baptist. I thought it wise to reiterate those changes as a way of reminding you of your giving options.

You can, of course, always give us cash. Just make sure that in making a cash donation to the church you put your name on the envelope so our financial secretary will know to whom to credit the gift. Or you can make a donation to the church by means of a check, simply making the check payable to Vineville Baptist Church.

But you can also donate to the church through Bill Pay at your bank. That is to say, you can donate to the church online through the internet banking option provided by your bank. All you would need to do is to add Vineville Baptist Church as a payee for an automatic deduction from your bank account. You can set up your bill pay schedule as a single or ongoing online offering to the church. The great advantage of utilizing this option is that there is no cost to the church.

We have now made available to you the option of paying by accessing our website (www.vinevillebaptistchurch.org). There is a link at the top of our webpage that says "Give Online." You will need to provide your email address to register for this option. For many of you, donating through online giving has become your new normal. I would add however, that if you choose this option the church will incur bank service fees. That is to say, if you choose to make your donation by using a credit card or debit card, the church will be charged a bank fee that is approximately 3% of the total gift. So, if you donate \$100 through online giving, approximately \$3 will go to the bank. If you use your checking account for online giving the church is charged a smaller fee, approximately 1% of the total gift.

There is yet another option. You can donate to the church through your smartphone. Using the QR reader on your smart phone, you will need to scan the church QR code, which is located on our church bulletin. This will link you directly to our website to donate through the online option that I described above. As with the online option, the church will incur bank fees, approximately 3% if using your credit or debit card, 1% if using your bank account.

However you give, please be conscientious in your stewardship. There are so many worthy ministries and forms of outreach taking place at Vineville this fall. Let us band together to make sure that we provide sufficient resources to underwrite our work in behalf of God's Kingdom. On a related matter, committee chairs, you will be soon be receiving a letter from me soliciting your input as we set about the process of crafting the 2019 budget. Please be thoughtful and prompt in your response.

We look forward to a great day tomorrow, the 44th Annual Vineville Baptist Golf Tournament. Let's hope the weather permits us to enjoy our time of fun and fellowship.

Also, we are continuing to solicit volunteers to provide baked goods for sale at our Fall Bazaar, which takes place September 28 and 29. If you can provide any goodies for the event, please let Harold McAbee know. If you can volunteer in any capacity, please let Harold know that, too. The hours of the Fall Bazaar are 5 pm - 8 pm on Friday, and 8 am - 2 pm on Saturday. And if you can stay after Bible study on Wednesday, September 26, we could use your help in helping set up the gym for the Bazaar that night.
