## 2K Circle Time Focus

## 3K Circle Time Focus

This month, Mrs. Roslyn’s class is focusing on the colors blue and red, the qualities of a circle and square, and also recognizing and sounding out A, B, C, D, E, F. They are writing their names every-day, spelling them, utilizing sensory learning (getting messy!) and focusing on playing together and sharing. They love looking at books, so make sure to spend time reading with them at home, too! It makes a big difference!

## 4K Circle Time Focus

Mrs. Amanda’s class will be talking about different types of transportation followed by Life on the Farm and how we get veggies to the grocery store! Socially, they’ll be learning to appreciate the differences in others after focusing on “I am ME” in August. They are reading books and playing educational games each day. Encourage your children to write their full names and teach YOU what they are learning at school!
